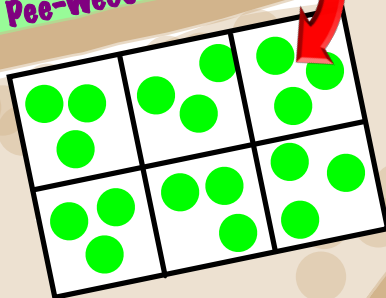


# Good morning!
