Length of Feet (Skates)
Length of Arms (Jacket)
Circumference Head (Hat)
Length of Legs (Snow Pants)
Length of Hands (Gloves)

Be creative with your measurements, but try to use one Standard and one Non-Standard for each clothing item.

<u>Standard Measurements</u> are units of measurement everyone uses, like inches or centimeters on a ruler. Tape measures can help to measure when you need a more flexible tool.

<u>Non-Standard Measurements</u> are any tools or resources you can use to measure an object.
